



BCA-SWI Professional Women in Building 2025-2026 School Year Trade Education Scholarship Application



BCA-SWI PWB Scholarship Overview:

The Building Contractors Association of Southwestern Idaho's Professional Women in Building (BCA-SWI PWB) has an established scholarship program to support those looking to enter the building industry. Each year, BCA-SWI PWB will award scholarships to students pursuing a career in a construction related field. Preference for scholarships will be given by discretion of a panel to students pursuing construction-related education and students affiliated West Ada Career and Technical Education Program. The scholarship may be used to fund trade education. Monies will be paid directly to the school or training program of choice of the winners to help defray the cost of tuition. Recipients may be awarded up to \$3,000 per academic year. Applicant must be at least Grade 12 or equivalent to apply.

Academic Year

The scholarship award must be used in the 2025-2026 Academic Year (Summer 2025, Fall 2025, and Spring 2026)

Geographical Limits:

Qualifying students must reside in the BCA-SWI Membership geographical areas of Ada, Adams, Valley, Boise, Elmore and Camas counties.

Distribution of Funds:

Scholarship recipients are required to submit proof of enrollment and upcoming class schedules to BCA-SWI PWB. Upon award selection, BCA-SWI PWB will send a check directly to the designated school. Scholarship recipients may also be required to submit to BCA-SWI PWB a copy of their tuition expense receipt.

Subsequent Scholarships:

Scholarship recipients are welcome to reapply for aid in subsequent academic years. Note: Previous scholarship recipients must submit a separate application for each subsequent award. Previous recipients may skip section V-B and will not need to provide reference letters; however, previous recipients must submit transcripts with the application. Previous awards do not guarantee subsequent award selection.

Application Deadline:

Applicant is responsible to ensure that all application materials and requirements are submitted to the Building Contractors Association of Southwestern Idaho by April 17th. Application must be complete, or it will not be considered.

Notification:

Those individuals selected to receive a scholarship will be notified by the end of April and may be recognized at an awards ceremony at the BCA-SWI Professional Women in Building Parade of Homes® Pet House Edition. Those not receiving a scholarship will be notified by email.
